ZOOMING TOGETHER - How To Register

As has always been our policy, all TEMV members and friends, and your relatives and friends, are welcome to join us for all services and programs. Almost all High Holy Day worship and learning will be conducted remotely on Zoom. **Please note, each person who will be using a computer or phone to join MUST REGISTER IN ADVANCE to be admitted to the remote service.** Each registrant will receive a unique link to join the services for which they register. If you are attending with friends or family from one location, just one person may register for the screen on which you will be joining (but you are encouraged to have each person have their own device to participate in breakout rooms or other activities).

HOW DO I GET A PRAYERBOOK/MACHZOR?

While some prayers or songs may be shared on the screen, most of the time you will need a machzor (prayer book).

All households that were members of TEMV on April 30, 2020, will receive a bag including the loan of enough machzorim (prayerbooks) for the members of their household. These machzorim are on loan and will need to be returned after the holidays. The totes also contain many gifts and goodies. These will be available for pick-up on August 30 and September 13, or by prior arrangement with Karen at klipshires@gmail.com.

Those who are not members of TEMV are welcome and encouraged to register for our services, but will need to acquire their own book.
